

EMMAUS SPONSOR CHECKLIST: Sponsor Responsibilities after Sponsorship: Things to Do:

- Pray daily for your pilgrim and for those involved in Walk #_____
- Contact your pilgrim immediately. Answer any questions they may have and encourage them to return the Acceptance Letter, provided to the pilgrim postal mail from the Emmaus Registrar. A verbal confirmation to the Registrar/or sponsor chairperson that is acceptable if the Acceptance Letter was not received
- Mark the walk dates on your calendar
- Begin contacting friends and family to get **“at least” 12 agape letters, we encourage. Any additional letter will be provided in their yellow packages to read at a later time.**
You will want to ensure that **friends or family is written in the bottom left corner** and the pilgrims name is on the outside of the envelope.
- Talk with pilgrim about family needs during the Emmaus weekend. Sponsor should make arrangements to meet those needs.
- Ask about money. The weekend cost is \$125. The total or any remaining cost of the Walk is payable at Sendoff by check or cash only. Checks made payable to Heart of Georgia Emmaus
- Bring your pilgrim to **Send-off at Dooly Campground, to the tabernacle, at 6-6:30 p.m. on Thursday** for registration and cabin assignments. Send off will begin at 7:00 p.m. Ensure pilgrim does not have possession of a cell phone or watch that will be a distraction during the walk.
- Plan to stay for Sponsor’s Hour Service after Send-off.** Sponsor’s Hour is held in the St. Paul’s Chapel immediately following sendoff. Should you be unable to attend please ensure someone attends on your behalf.
- Candlelight is at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday in the tabernacle.** Please plan to bring all agape letters and place them in the bin that will be available.
- Closing Services are at 4:30 p.m on Sunday. Plan to arrive around 4:00 p.m.** to gather your pilgrim’s belongings from the cabin and their yellow bag that will be located in the front of the Conference Room weather permitting. Should it be raining, the yellow bags will be available in the Tabernacle.
- Remind pilgrim they may wish to bring cash or check should they see something they wish to purchase during the weekend. (At the book sale)
- Sign prayer vigil located on <https://signupschedule.com/hogemmaus> for a reserved date and time for prayer. Provide email for email notification reminders.

After Walk is complete:

- Talk with your pilgrim about Fourth Day.
- Bring your pilgrim to a local Cluster meeting.
- Help the pilgrim become involved in a Reunion Group.

Pilgrim Should Plan to Bring:

Twin Bedding and Pillow
Toiletries, (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
Towel and face cloth
Flashlight
Umbrella, Coat or light Jacket
